Role and mandate of CARPA

The **Support Council for the Realization of Partnership Contracts (CARPA)** is an expert body created by Decree No. 2008/035 of January 23, 2008 amended and supplemented by Decree No. 2012/148 of March 21, 2012.

It is placed under the supervision of the Minister in charge of the Economy.

CARPA's mandate is to contribute, through its expertise, to the creation and renewal of public infrastructure and equipment, as well as to the improvement of the quality of public service within the framework of large-scale technical and financial projects to be carried out through a partnership agreement.

Among its regulatory mandates is that consisting of training, the development of national expertise and monitoring in terms of innovation on the methods of management of public projects within the framework of a partnership contract. It is in this context that its training program is described below, intended for professionals from the private sector and executives of public administrations interested or called upon to intervene as experts in the implementation of public projects to be carried out in Public-Private Partnership (PPP). This program was developed with support from the World Bank for the benefit of CARPA, through the Public-Private Infrastructure Advisory Fund (PPIAF).

Certification Program Sponsors

The International Foundation Certification is part of the Certified PPP Professional Program (CP3P©), promoted by the Asian Development Bank (ADB), the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), the Islamic Development Bank (IDB), the Multilateral Investment Fund (MIF), the World Bank Group (WBG) and the Public-Private Infrastructure Advisory Facility (PPIAF). The certification is designed and managed by APMG INTERNATIONAL based in London.

The Public-Private Partnership (PPP) is a mode of collaboration by which the public authority calls on private service providers to finance, design, build, operate and maintain, for a period depending on the amortization of the investments, public infrastructure in different areas of socio-economic activity (transport, energy, health, education, municipal services, etc.). The inherent **complexity** of this legal and financial instrument requires the development of high capacities of public and private actors, in particular to guarantee fair contracts that respect the interests of each of the parties.

The National Development Strategy (SND30) recently adopted by the Cameroonian Government provides for a set of major infrastructure projects amounting to **37,500 billion CFA francs for the present decade 2020-2030**. Several of these projects will be carried out in PPP mode. It is therefore important for public and private actors called upon or interested in intervening in this vast investment program, and more particularly Cameroonian lawyers, to better train themselves on PPPs in order to seize this niche of opportunities.

The first condition for achieving this is to appropriate the legal regime of this new method of public procurement, and above all to master its principles and mechanisms.

This is why it is important to seize the opportunity of this training, in order to acquire this high-level expertise in an extremely promising field.

Preparation process

The first phase of the preparation is individual and is essentially the responsibility of each of the candidates.

It will thus consist for them, in the complete and meticulous reading of the documentation which will be given to them prior to the face-to-face training session..

The second phase of the preparation, spread over 5 days, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. (with coffee breaks and lunches), revolves around :

- ✓ 10 (ten) explanatory presentations and discussions on the course documents submitted;
- ✓ 3 (three) assessment tests;
- ✓ 1 (one) mock exam on the APMG platform;
- ✓ General reviews;
- ✓ The actual exam for those who feel ready.
