PRESS RELEASE

The Chairperson of the Support Council for the Realization of Partnership Contracts hereby communicates as follows:

CARPA was invited to appoint representatives within the Monitoring Committee of the contract relating to the security control system at Cameroon international airports. The contract is worth an amount of 92.036 billion CFA Francs (tax excluded), with the private partner compensation based on the user fee throughout the operation (extensible) duration.

Since 15 January 2026, CARPA as indicated that this approach does not comply with the legal applicable procedure. Subsequently, CARPA identified basic inconsistencies deriving, *inter alia*, from asymmetric information concerning:

- Availability of the feasibility file (feasibility study not made available to relevant administrations for review, lack of investment and maintenance financing plan, etc....);
- Functional engagement of the selected private partner, as well as his track record, in carrying out similar projects.

The details of this notice have been brought to the attention of the relevant administrations.

While drawing attention to the weaknesses in both the form and substance of this contract, CARPA leaves it up to stakeholders involved in its drafting and implementation, to assume full responsibility for its short, mid and long term socioeconomic, financial and accounting impacts.
