1. PRESENTATION OF CARPA

The Support Council for the Realization of Partnership Contracts (CARPA) is the Cameroonian government's expert body on public-private partnership (PPP) contracts. Established by Law No. 2006/012 of December 29, 2006, which sets out the general rules for partnership contracts, and created by Decree No. 2008/035 of January 23, 2008, which sets out its organization and functioning, CARPA's main mandate is to contribute, through its expertise, to the development of infrastructure and the improvement of public service quality. As such, it is responsible, among other things, for (i) promoting and disseminating information on the Cameroonian PPP regime, (ii) training public and private actors, (iii) developing national expertise in PPPs, and (iv) monitoring innovation in public project management methods within the framework of PPPs. Under the technical supervision of the Ministry of Economy, Planning, and Regional Development (MINEPAT), CARPA has, since 2009, assisted public actors in the appraisal of 86 projects, resulting in the award of some 30 PPP contracts, for a cumulative amount of nearly 3 trillion CFA francs.

Through training programs, CARPA has strengthened the capacities of several public sector officials, including central government agencies, public enterprises and institutions, and local authorities.

Since 2022, CARPA has developed preparatory training for the **Certified PPP Professional (CP3P)** international certification, with exams organized by APMG International, based in London, England. To date, nearly 100 public sector officials are CP3P Level I certified.

Since October 25, 2025, CARPA has been officially accredited as a **CP3P Accredited Training Organization**, i.e., an accredited training organization for APMG International's PPP Certification, thus becoming the first and only PPP Unit in the world accredited as an APMG International training organization.

Building on this recognition, and with a view to developing and consolidating high-level national expertise in PPP, CARPA is pleased to present its 2026 training program for International PPP Certification.

2. 2026 TRAINING PROPOSAL

3. PRESENTATION OF THE CP3P INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATION

The Certified PPP Professional (CP3P®) international certification is promoted by the Asian Development Bank (ADB), the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), the Islamic Development Bank (IDB), the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), the Multilateral Investment Fund (MIF), and the World Bank Group (WBG), and is partly funded by the Public-Private Infrastructure Advisory Facility (PPIAF). The certification is managed by APMG INTERNATIONAL, based in London, which organizes the exam.

Holders of this certification are recognized worldwide as *Certified Public Private Partnerships Professionals (CP3P)*, i.e., *PPP Experts*.

Prior to the training workshop, participants will receive documentation to read.

The training courses are prepared and led by experienced PPP Experts, who are themselves fully CP3P certified.

The cost of the training course indicated above covers all expenses, including exam fees (vouchers), but excludes participants' accommodation costs.

4. JUSTIFICATION OF THE TRAINING

Public-private partnerships (PPPs) are, broadly speaking, a form of collaboration between a public authority and one or more private providers with a view to finance, design, build or rehabilitate, operate, and maintain, for a period depending on the amortization of the investments, public infrastructure in various socio-economic fields (transport, energy, health, education, municipal services, etc.). The inherent complexity of this legal and financial tool requires the development of high-level capacities among public and private actors, in particular to ensure balanced contracts that respect the interests of each party.

In its recently adopted National Development Strategy (NDS30), the Cameroonian government has planned a series of major infrastructure projects worth 37.5 trillion CFA francs for the current decade 2020-2030. Most of these projects will be carried out in PPP mode. It is therefore important for public and private actors called upon or interested in participating in this vast investment program in any capacity, to be well trained in PPP techniques in order to seize this niche of opportunities.

This training course is therefore an opportunity to acquire high-level expertise in an extremely complex but promising field.
